## **Giving Thanks to God--For What?**

While we certainly can thank God for anything and everything, I thought it might be interesting to search the Scriptures to see what the Bible says we should thank God for (by way of Biblical examples). I examined every verse in the Bible using the words thank, thanked, thankful, thankfulness, thanking, thanks, thanksgiving, thanksgivings and <u>praise</u> (where the Hebrew term <u>vadah</u> means to praise or to give thanks). Here is the result of this study:

These first two categories were the most common reasons for thanking God, "for He is good and His mercy endureth forever."

Thanking God for His **goodness** (Ps. 100:4-5; 2 Chron. 5:13; 1 Chron. 16:34; Ezra 3:11; Ps. 106:1; 107:1,8,15,21,31; 118:1,29; 136:1)

Thanking God for His <u>mercy</u>/faithful love/lovingkindness (Ps. 100:4-5; 2 Chron. 5:13; 1 Chron. 16:34,41; Ezra 3:11; Ps. 92:1-2; 106:1; 107:1; 118:1,29; 136:1-3,26)

Thanking God for His truth/faithfulness (Psalm 100:4-5; Ps. 92:1-2)

Thanking God for WHO HE IS (1 Chron. 29:13 in context; Ps. 95:2-3; 122:4; 140:13)

Thanking God for His wonderful works (Ps. 107:8,15,21, 22,31)

Thanking God for His holiness (Ps. 30:4; 97:12; 106:47)

Thanking God for His righteous judgments (Ps. 119:62)

Thanking God for giving us His wisdom (Dan. 2:23)

Thanking God for hearing our cry (Psalm 118:21)

Thanking God for our daily bread (Matt. 15:36; Mark 8:6; John 6:11,23; Acts 27:35; Rom. 14:6; 1 Tim. 4:3-4)

Thanking God for victory and deliverance from sin (Rom. 7:25; 1 Cor. 15:57; 2 Cor. 2:14)

Thanking God that we are no longer slaves to sin but now slaves to righteousness (Rom. 6:17-18)

Thanking God for His enablement for service (1 Tim. 1:2)

Thanking God for His future reign (Rev. 11:17)

Thanking God for the faith of believers (Rom. 1:8; 2 Thess. 1:3; Philemon 4-5; Col. 1:3-4; 1 Thess. 1:2-3); for the love of believers (2 Thess. 1:3; Philemon 4-5; Col. 1:3-4; 1 Thess. 1:2-3); for the hope of believers (1 Thess. 1:2-3); for the grace given to believers (1 Cor. 1:4)

Thanking God for bringing other believers to mind (Phil. 1:3; 2 Tim. 1:3)

Thanking God for believers who receive God's Word for what it is (1 Thess. 2:13)

Thanking God for the joy that believers can bring to other believers (1 Thess. 3:9)

Thanking God for the encouragement that comes from other believers (Acts 28:15)

Thanking God for His unspeakable gift of salvation (2 Cor. 9:15; Col. 1:12-13)

Thanking God for believers being chosen by God (2 Thess. 2:13)

Thanking God for our mission field (1 Tim. 2:1-4)

Thanking God for all things (Eph. 5:20; 1 Thess. 5:18; Col. 3:17)
